We will be holding a parent information meeting on Wednesday afternoon from 3pm in the Pre-Primary classroom. All parents, including those with children in other grades, are welcome to attend to learn more about the approach. Over the coming terms, our Year 1 and 2 staff will also begin to incorporate this approach into their classrooms.
